Federal Firearms License Holders:

The Law Enforcement Protection Program has been in effect since 1998. In 2008, the Kentucky General Assembly made the Kentucky State Police the administrator of the forfeited gun sales. The proceeds from the sales of confiscated firearms have been instrumental in equipping Kentucky law enforcement personnel with personal body armor and other equipment which enable officers to better serve the citizens of Kentucky.

There are few changes that will be noticeable to federally licensed firearms buyers that attend these auctions. Attached are the procedures for registration and participation.

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AUCTION REGISTRATION & PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. General information, registration instructions, and sale dates can be found at www.kentuckystatepolice.org or may be obtained by contacting the Kentucky State Police at 502-782-2060.
2. All sales will take place at the Kentucky State Police Supply Branch, located at 94 Airport Road, Frankfort, KY.
3. Pursuant to KRS 16.220, all Federal Firearms License (FFL) dealers are eligible to participate in these auctions. However, pre-registration is mandatory for participation.

...all firearms confiscated by the Department of Kentucky State Police and not retained for official use pursuant to KRS 500.090 shall be sold at public auction to federally licensed firearms dealers holding a license appropriate for the type of firearm sold.

4. To register, FFL dealers must complete the attached registration application and return it to the Kentucky State Police, along with a certified copy of their FFL, at least seven (7) business days prior to the next regularly scheduled sale.
5. Registration will be valid for up to one (1) year or until June 30th, whichever is less. However, the Kentucky State Police retains the right to require registrants to re-register at any time.
6. The Kentucky State Police retains the right to validate the current FFL status of all registered participants prior to the next sale.
7. On approval, the registration information will be entered into a secure database that will be used for verification upon the participant's arrival at an auction. On the day of the auction, all participants must present two (2) forms of identification, including one (1) photo identification, at time of registration.
8. The Kentucky State Police retains the right to check the legal ability of participants to receive firearms before any firearms are issued on the day of sale.
9. Approved methods of payment include certified check, cashier's check or personal check with a bank letter.
10. Allow 7-14 days for submitted checks to be processed. For returned checks a \$50.00 processing fee will apply.
