502 KAR 11:010, Application for license to carry concealed deadly weapon, has been filed with the Legislative Research Commission for amendment. This administrative regulation establishes the application form and procedures. This amendment updates the regulation to reflect current practices and procedures for application for a concealed carry of deadly weapons license. An electronic application process is provided. The source of an operator's license or identification card is updated. The procedures for completing a physical application are updated. The "CCDW LEOSA Application Mailing Schedule for Sheriffs" and the "Issuance Notice" forms are eliminated. The location for inspection, copying, obtaining materials incorporated by reference is updated.

This amendment updates the regulation to reflect current practices and procedures. The regulation is adapted to reflect an automated notification and appeals process.
