502 KAR 15:010, Traffic collision reports, has been filed with the Legislative Research Commission for amendment. This administrative regulation establishes the reporting system, dissemination procedures, forms, and fee schedule for traffic collision reports. This administrative regulation is revised to bring it into alignment with current Kentucky State Police procedures. The revision adds definitions and provides for electronic submission of collision reports through the online portal. It updates the procedure to direct law enforcement agencies to submit collision reports electronically in the online portal. The revision requires certification as a news gathering organization for parties requesting collision reports pursuant to KRS 189.635(8). The KSP-74 "Kentucky Uniform Police Traffic Collision Report" is revised and converted to an electronically populated report; the format is updated for visual layout and to add boxes to collect information related to commercial vehicles and collision reconstruction. The KSP-29 "News-Gathering Organization Certification" form is incorporated by reference. The location for inspection, copying, obtaining materials incorporated by reference is updated.
