This administrative regulation establishes the procedures for the entry and retrieval of missing child information. Procedures for parent or guardian to enter information directly into MCIC are eliminated. The regulation is adapted for an electronic reporting process.

502 KAR 35:040, Reporting of missing children by law enforcement agencies, has been filed with the Legislative Research Commission for amendment. This administrative regulation establishes procedures and time frames associated with the reporting of a missing child. The regulation is adapted for an electronic reporting process. The KSP-261 "Kentucky Missing Persons Report Form" is formatted for an electronic submission process. Reporting agencies shall retain responsibility for ongoing investigation of missing child incidents when the incident is entered on behalf of the reporting agency by a Kentucky State Police post. The Kentucky Missing Persons Website is created and procedures are established for the information located on it.
